Palazzo Bozzi Corso, Lecce

This historical palazzo in the heart of Lecce is ideal for a romantic weekend in the city, offering utter relaxation, style, and good food. Moments away you'll find the glitter and lights of the Baroque city's holiday atmosphere. Stroll or cycle to visit the *Basilica of Santa Croce, Piazza Sant'Oronzo* with ruins of an ancient Roman *amphitheater*, and *Piazza Duomo* with its climbable bell tower from which you can enjoy views as far as the sea.

The walls of the palace are home to private artworks that recall the story of the Fiermontina family; each Suite tells a story, starting with **Jacques Zwobada** (1900-1967) and **René Letourneur** (1898-1990), two of the most interesting artists in the panorama of European sculpture in the first half of the 20th century, whose works can be admired in the house.


